Certain Dangerous Cargo

Mariners are advised that our operations center (Seaway Beauharnois) must be advised ahead of time of a transit of a ship with « certain dangerous cargo », as defined in Transport Canada's Marine Transportation Security Regulations (DORS32004-144).

Certain dangerous cargos are categorized as the following:

Class 1 – Explosives

Class 2 – Gases

Class 5 – Oxidizing substances and organic peroxides

Class 6 – Toxic (poisonous) and infectious substances

Class 7 – Radioactive material and nuclear substances

A declaration of security (DOS) is required for these transits with « certain dangerous cargo ». The declaration must be sent to us before the transit, preferably with the dangerous cargo plan.
