Water Level Fluctuations on Lake St. Francis & Lake St. Louis Due to Salvage Operations **(Cancelled 2015/07/23)**

Mariners are advised that beginning July 24, 2015 outflows from the Moses-Saunders Power Dam will be reduced during daylight hours on a daily basis to assist with the salvage operations of two tugs which capsized in the St. Lawrence River below the Seaway International Bridge (outside of the Seaway channel). During such time, water levels on Lake St. Francis and Lake St. Louis are expected to decrease, but remain above Seaway alert level. Conditions will be monitored closely and speed and/or meet restrictions will be implemented if necessary.

The salvage operation is expected to last up to 14 days. Mariners will be advised once salvage operations are complete.
