SEAWAY NOTICE NO. 8 – 2012

Speed Limits on Lake St. Louis

Effective March 22, 2012, the speed limit on Lake St. Louis between A13 and the lower entrance of the Lower Beauharnois Lock will be reduced from 16 knots to **12 knots for upbound** vessels and **14 knots for downbound** vessel, as indicated in **Column III** below.

Further changes to the Table of Speeds are also being introduced for the same area, 11 knots for upbound vessels and 13 knots for downbound vessels as indicated in Column IV below. The Column IV limits may be applied when low water level conditions apply, along with other restrictions that may be required. Mariners will be advised via a Notice to Shipping should this be the case.
