Tug Available for Assistance at Beauharnois Lock 3
(Cancelled 2019/08/24)

Mariners are advised that a tug will be available for assistance with the upbound approach at Beauharnois Lock 3, beginning late afternoon on July 26, 2019.

- For each upbound transit, the tug will escort the vessel to, or close to, the lower approach wall.
- Upbound vessels are to contact the Operations Control Centre (OCC) at Saint Nicolas Island and provide their ETA for buoys A51-A52.
- The OCC will advise the tug to prepare for the approaching vessel.
- In the area of call-in-point 3 (CIP3), the tug captain will arrange with the vessel master or pilot the type of assistance required and the VHF working frequency.
- The tug will meet the vessel close to buoys A51-A52 (not less than 1 NM from the approach wall)
- There shall be no meets within 1000m downstream of the end of wall, as per Notice to Shipping #18, 2019.
- Downbound vessels exiting lock 3 will be held in the lock until the upbound vessel is stopped in position on the lower wall (LA 3/LA 2).
