Revised Vessel Speed Restriction - Brockville Narrows to Prescott (Cancelled 2019/09/12)

This notice rescinds Notice to Shipping No. 14 of 2019.

Mariners are advised that currents are increasing in the upper St. Lawrence River. As a result, in order to maintain safe ship maneuverability, the speed restriction for downbound ships has been revised.

Between buoy 132 and light 147:

- **Downbound ships are limited to 10.5 knots** (Column IV of Schedule II – Table of Speeds) in the Seaway Handbook Practices & Procedures)
- **Upbound ships continue to be limited to 8.5 knots**

Vessel speeds will be monitored closely and there will be zero tolerance for ships exceeding the speed limit.

Mariners are also reminded to watch their wake, particularly when navigating close to shore.

We will continue to closely monitor the conditions and inform you of any change.
