WOODEN STAND-OFFS AT WHARF 18.3 – PORT COLBORNE HARBOUR

Masters are advised that the wooden stand-offs previously deployed at Wharf 18.3 have, for many years now, been removed and are being stored at our Port Colborne yard. In case of an emergency / winter lay-up situation, etc. the stand-offs can be put back in the water with a minimum 48 hours notice.

Please note that the limiting depth at Wharf 18.3 without the stand-offs in place is 6.71 meters (22 feet) at chart datum of 173.50 meters. With the stand-offs in place the wharf can accommodate maximum draft of 8.08 meters (26 feet 6 inches).

Vessels intending to use this wharf must maintain a minimum under the keel clearance of 0.15 meters and must include this factor when applying the Lake Erie water elevation.
