NEW - LIMIT OF APPROACH No. 3 SIGNS

Mariners are advised of two new "Limit of Approach No.3 signs installed on the upper wall above Lock 1 and the upper east wall above Lock 7.

The Limit of Approach **No.3** on the upper east wall above Lock 7 is located 160 meters south of the Checkerboard sign and is the new default mooring position for all downbound vessels. If the Traffic Controller determines the need to secure a second vessel, the first vessel can be shifted down to the Checkerboard sign.

The Limit of Approach **No.3** on the upper wall above Lock 1 is located 260 meters from the end of the wall and can be used as a distance marker when making a passing entry manoeuvre or as a mooring position for a vessel making a modified passing entry manoeuvre.
