**Increased Outflows – Montreal Lake Ontario Section**

Pleasure craft operators are advised that in order to help alleviate flooding conditions around Lake Ontario, the International Lake Ontario St. Lawrence River Board has ordered that outflows through the Moses-Saunders dam be increased in stages from **10,200** cubic meters per second ( $m^3/s$ ) to **10,400**  $m^3/s$  as follows:

- From 10,200  $m^3/s$  to 10,250  $m^3/s$  on 10 June 2019 at 00:01
- From 10,250  $m^3/s$  to 10,300  $m^3/s$  on 11 June 2019 at 00:01
- From 10,300  $m^3/s$  to 10,350  $m^3/s$  on 12 June 2019 at 00:01
- From 10,350  $m^3/s$  to 10,400  $m^3/s$  on 13 June 2019 at 00:01

The Seaway plans to continue commercial navigation despite the increased outflows. However, please note that this will create velocities higher than normal in the navigation channels and variations in the normal current patterns may occur.

Extreme caution is requested during this period.

Pleasure craft will be advised, through a bulletin, when the above situation will return to normal.
