**Water Levels on Lake St. Louis (Revised)** (Cancelled 2013/11/22)

Mariners are advised that despite recent precipitation and outflow changes, the average daily water level on Lake St. Louis is decreasing. As a result, the speed restrictions outlined in Notice to Shipping #24 of 2013 (Montreal/Lake Ontario Section) are once again in effect. (Notice to Shipping #25 of 2013 has been cancelled.)

Therefore, the speed limits between buoys A30 and A40 are reduced as follows:

- Vessels with a draft greater than 70 dm are limited to 11 knots upbound and 13 knots downbound.

For vessels with a draft of 70 dm or less, the speed limit remains limited to 12 knots upbound and 14 knots downbound respectively. Vessel speeds will be monitored closely.

We will continue to closely monitor the conditions and advise you of any other changes.
