Pleasure Craft Lockage Season at Iroquois Lock

New Online Reservation System

New this year, pleasure craft users wanting to transit the Iroquois lock are required to make an online reservation in advance. The online reservation system remains in effect for users wanting to transit St. Lambert, Côte Sainte-Catherine and Beauharnois locks.

Going forward, at all Canadian locks, including Iroquois, a lockage for upbound pleasure crafts and another one for downbound pleasure crafts in the morning and a lockage for upbound pleasure crafts and another one for downbound pleasure crafts in the afternoon will be scheduled. Availability will be limited, therefore, in order to ensure a passage through one of the Canadian locks, including Iroquois lock, pleasure craft users are now required to make a reservation in advance.

The rights of way of payments at all Canadian Locks must be made using the same online reservation system. Cash is no longer accepted as payment for tolls at Canadian locks.

Pleasure craft users must:

- Complete an online pleasure craft reservation in advance.
- On the day of the transit, consult the schedule in order to find the lockage times for the day (information on lockages are revised daily at approximately 07:30 a.m.):
 - Lockage schedule for mobile phone (JavaScript must be activated)
 - Lockage schedule
 - Audio message indicating the lockage schedule, at 450-672-4115, ext. 2235
- Pleasure craft users with a confirmed reservation (printed or electronic version) are required to arrive at the pleasure craft dock one hour before the scheduled lockage time and await further instructions.

Pleasure Craft users wishing to cross the international border to transit the locks should first consult with CBSA or Homeland Security as the right of innocent passage may not apply for transit in the locks as a result of COVID-19 restrictions.
