ST. LAWRENCE SEAWAY MANAGEMENT CORPORATION AND UNIFOR RATIFY NEW COLLECTIVE BARGAINING AGREEMENTS

Cornwall, Ontario (November 30, 2021) - The St. Lawrence Seaway Management Corporation (SLSMC) and UNIFOR Operational and Maintenance Group, Cornwall Headquarters as well as Supervisory Group bargaining units recently ratified new collective bargaining agreements. The agreements are for a period of 2 years until March 31st, 2023.

With all agreements now ratified, the SLSMC continues its commitment to the stability of the Seaway and to ensuring that its customers will continue to benefit from uninterrupted safe and reliable navigation.
