



## SEAWAY NOTICE NO. 10 - 2022

### **U.S. COAST GUARD SECURITY BOARDING LOCATION CHANGE**

U.S. Coast Guard Sector Buffalo has temporarily changed the location where they will conduct security boardings on ships transiting the Saint Lawrence River and the Great Lakes bound for U.S. ports. Security Boardings will now occur at anchor in the designated Tibbett's Point Anchorage Area. Mariners are advised that:

- The U.S. Coast Guard will contact ships before they enter Lake Ontario. Commander, Sector Buffalo will then issue a Captain of the Port (COTP) Order directing the ship to anchorage.
- U.S. Coast Guard boarding teams will embark ships after they arrive at the designated anchorage and complete the anchoring evolution.
- Upon completion of the boarding, Sector Buffalo will issue a letter rescinding the COTP Order. The ship may proceed to its destination port when the boarding team has safely disembarked.
- Other U.S. Coast Guard security boarding procedures remain the same as before.
