SEAWAY NOTICE NO. 8 – 2022

REQUEST FOR NOTIFICATION OF ANY PERSON OR CREW MEMBER ON BOARD WITH SERIOUS ILLNESS OR COVID-19 SYMPTOMS

The St. Lawrence Seaway Management Corporation has put a series of measures in place to ensure the continuity of operations for both domestic and ocean ships. These measures are designed to maintain an efficient transportation system while safeguarding the welfare of all personnel.

For ocean ships coming into the St. Lawrence Seaway, adherence to the 96 hour advance notice of arrival to the Government of Canada is essential. As per Transport Canada's Ship Safety Bulletin 02/2021, Masters of inland and ocean ships transiting in Canadian waters west of the St. Lambert lock on the St. Lawrence River and in the Great Lakes must report whether any person or crew member on board has a serious illness or any COVID-19 symptom to the appropriate Traffic Control Center. For the Seaway:

- Ships between CIP2 and mid-Lake Ontario must call St. Lambert Traffic Control at: 450-672-4110 ext. 2232
- Ships between mid-Lake Ontario and CIP16 must call Niagara Traffic Control at: 905-641-1932 ext. 5370

Please be assured, the current health crisis related to COVID-19 has our full attention and the situation is being constantly monitored. We will keep you informed of any changes.
