



## SEAWAY NOTICE NO. 15 – 2022

### CRUISE SHIPS IN THE SEAWAY

**(Cancelled 2022/10/06)**

Any cruise ship intending to transit the Seaway should take note of the following:

- Advance notification to the SLSMC is required for use of lines in the locks if the cruise ship is not compatible with Hands-Free Mooring or not able to be processed in the locks without mooring lines.
- The current SLSMC security plan allows for stops at Wharf 2 and Wharf 16 only in the Welland Canal (stop and go only).
- Provisions are to be made with the lessee of wharfs 2 and 16 (cruise ship terminal operator / logistics provider) for tie-up services.
- Reminder that cruise ships must follow requirements set out in Transport Canada Marine Safety and Security (TCMSS) Ship Safety Bulletin No. 18/2021 and have various measures in place.
