**SHIP CHANDLER INTERFACES WITH SHIPS AT THE WHARVES IN
THE WELLAND CANAL**

Ship chandler interfaces with ships will be permitted at Wharves 2, 12 South and 16 as per the details outlined below.

Wharf 2 and Wharf 16

- Stores/supplies will be permitted at Wharf 2 and Wharf 16.
- Arrangements are to be made with the tenants for cost, timing and availability.

Wharf 12 South

To ensure compliance with the Marine Transportation Security Regulations (MTSR), security arrangements are required for any ship to shore interface at Wharf 12 South. The following steps are to be followed in order to facilitate the interface:

- 1) Ship is to inform the Seaway of their intent to stop at Wharf 12 South at least 6 hours prior to the intended interface.
- 2) The Seaway will provide direction on availability based on the date, time and duration of the request. Provide this information upon call-in.
- 3) Ship is to provide the name & phone number of a ship representative.
- 4) There will be a 4 hour minimum charge for security per interface.

The Ship must forward any documentation (i.e. crew list) requested by the Seaway (email : nrerie@seaway.ca).
