Pleasure Craft Lockages Suspended at Canadian Locks until Further Notice

Effective immediately, all pleasure craft lockages in the St. Lawrence Seaway are suspended. This suspension applies to both the Montreal / Lake Ontario section and the Welland Canal section of the Seaway.

The suspension of pleasure craft lockages reflects the need to minimize all non-essential interactions between Seaway personnel and members of the general public during the COVID-19 crisis.

The SLSMC has put in place a series of measures to ensure the continuity of operations on the St. Lawrence Seaway for both domestic and ocean vessels. These measures are designed to maintain an efficient transportation corridor into and out of the heartland of North America, ensuring that vital goods can reach their destinations.

Pleasure craft will be advised, through a bulletin, when the above situation will return to normal.
