Riprap Work Below Saint-Lambert Lock

Mariners are advised that riprap (rockfill) work will begin during the week of October 28<sup>th</sup> below Saint-Lambert lock for a duration of approximately 5 weeks.

To ensure ship safety, work will not take place in certain critical sections under these conditions:

- 1) No riprap work from the lower end of wall of Saint Lambert lock to 200m downstream of the end of wall when an upbound vessel is approaching the lock;
- 2) No riprap work within 200 meters above and below the Jacques Cartier bridge pillars when a ship is approaching (upbound or downbound);
- No barge loading below Jacques Cartier bridge when a ship is approaching (upbound or downbound). The barge may be present, but must be firmly secured.

The Maisonneuve traffic control center will be able to provide further information to mariners when operations are underway.
