

STATUTORY DECLARATION

IN RESPECT OF A FINAL CERTIFICATE OF COMPLETION

AND I MAKE THIS SOLEMN DECLARATION conscientiously believing it to be true, and knowing that it is of the same force and effect as if made under oath and by virtue of the Canada Evidence Act.

NOTE 1. Where Contractor is a corporation or a partnership, declarer's position in the corporation or partnership and the corporation or partnership name should be clearly shown in No. 1. Where Contractor is the person who makes the declaration, strike out "of" in the first line of No. 1.

NOTE 2. Where the Contractor is an individual he must make the declaration himself. Where the Contractor is a partnership the declaration must be made by one of the partners. Where the Contractor is an incorporated company the declaration must be made by the President, Vice-President, Secretary, Treasurer or a Director. If any other person makes this declaration, two copies of the by-law issued under the Corporation Seal authorising the individual to execute documents must be submitted with the first declaration on each contract.
