Glendale Avenue Bridge Reopens Ahead of Schedule

St. Catharines, Ontario (May 9, 2025) – The St. Lawrence Seaway Management Corporation (SLSMC) is pleased to confirm that the Glendale Avenue Bridge (Bridge 5) in St. Catharines is reopening ahead of schedule.

It will be open to vehicle and pedestrian traffic today. The bridge had been in the raised position since April 22 due to an issue with the expansion joint that prevented it from fully lowering.

Thanks to the commitment of crews working extended hours, repairs were completed safely and ahead of schedule. We thank the public, local stakeholders, and community partners for their continued cooperation and patience.
