Riprap Work Below Saint-Lambert Lock

Mariners are advised that riprap (rockfill) work has begun below Saint-Lambert lock and will continue through November 18.

To ensure ship safety, work will not take place in certain critical sections under these conditions:

- 1) No riprap work in the section between the end of the lower Saint-Lambert wall and 200 meters below the end of the wall when an upbound vessel is approaching the lock;
- 2) No riprap work within 200 meters above and below the Jacques Cartier bridge pillars when a ship is approaching (upbound or downbound);
- 3) No barge loading below Jacques Cartier bridge when a ship is approaching (upbound or downbound). The barge may be present, but must be firmly secured.

The Maisonneuve traffic control center will be able to provide further information to mariners when operations are underway.
